We have exciting news of a new partnership! Recently UOF was introduced to Musana Community Development Program. Founded in 2008 by Haril and Andrea Kazindra, it is located in the Iganga District of Uganda. Run by local Ugandans, it meets community needs through education, health care and skill development. Promoting sustainable solutions not dependence on charity. Like UOF they provide a boarding school for primary students, and healthcare to the local community through their clinic. Unlike UOF, they also have secondary and vocational schools. Their organizational model is based upon Ugandan-run operations and financial sustainability, meaning they are less dependent on foreign support to run their programs.

Don and Diane Lundsten, the co-chairs of our Board of Directors, had the opportunity to visit Musana this past November. They were excited by the success of their Christ centered work, and the quality of staff and facilities. They also felt a deep conviction that Musana was God's provision for Uganda Orphans Fund.

As the Board spoke more with Haril and Andrea, we all agreed that this wonderful organization would provide excellent opportunities for the kids of Kasozi. Furthermore, their extensive background in community healthcare would make our medical clinic a more effective outreach to the Kamuli District.

After much prayer and discussion, we have reached an agreement with Musana to take over the work of Uganda Orphans Fund. With the start of the school year in February, our primary students will be attending Musana's School in Iganga. Some of our secondary students will attend Musana's Vocational High School and some will continue at their current School, depending on the need of the student. Musana will spend 2020 upgrading the Kasozi campus so that it can reopen in 2021. Many of our staff will become part of the Musana Family and one UOF board member will take a seat on their board of directors to ensure a smooth transition.

Even though Musana's model is highly sustainable, taking on our Kasozi kids would not be possible without your continued support. You can continue to help students through child sponsorship in Musana's SHINE program or with general donations.

We are so excited to join with Musana and become a part of their vision, "to see rural communities in Uganda develop using sustainable solutions that give HOPE and DIGNITY to the most vulnerable."
